Encounter: The Aesthetic Landscape of Taiwanese Ceramics

Focusing on the intersection of ceramics and fine art, this exhibition showcases the diverse painting techniques and ceramic expressions developed from the 1950s and 1960s to the present day in Yingge, Taiwan—a place renowned for its rich history and its ceramic industry.

This is Taiwan's first major exhibition curated around the theme of "painters painting on ceramics." It offers a fresh perspective by highlighting artists' innovative efforts and remarkable achievements. Breaking away from traditional canvases and paper, these artists have used ceramics as their creative foundation, forging a new aesthetic that merges the dimensions of painting and sculpture.

The exhibited works combine styles such as

ink painting, oil painting, and watercolor, reflecting the diverse evolution of Taiwanese art—from figurative realism to modern abstraction and contemporary expressions. One of the exhibition's highlights is Ma Bai-shui's Taroko Landscape on a Square Ceramic Vase, where the majestic scenery of Taroko Gorge is vividly depicted on a 30 cm tall ceramic vase, showcasing Ma's distinctive brushwork and artistic style.

This special exhibition revisits the solid foundations of Taiwan's ceramic industry and the artistic development shaped by different eras. We warmly invite you to visit the Yingge Ceramics Museum during the exhibition period to experience this unique encounter between ceramics and fine art.

2025 New Taipei Austronesian Culture Festival

The Austronesian Fashion Show presents performances by Hualien's Alifes Cultural Arts Troupe, blending traditional elements with modern creativity. Representatives from domestic and international Austronesian communities will model their traditional attire, highlighting the cultural diversity of the Austronesian world. With over 20 performance groups from different regions, the music and dance programs celebrate traditional rhythms and global Austronesian influences. The craft workshops invite indigenous artisans to demonstrate traditional garment-making techniques while exploring how gender roles in textile production have evolved in recent years. The creative market features

40+ stalls of cultural goods and global Austronesian cuisine, offering an immersive experience without leaving Taiwan.

The special exhibition, "Island Threads: Ancient Austronesian Attire," displays artifacts from five archaeological sites and five international Austronesian cultures, as well as traditional garments from four major Indigenous groups in Hualien. From bark cloth to weaving traditions, the exhibit showcases sustainable practices and deepens understanding of the cultural meaning woven into ancient clothing.

The opening program features the AniNgu Theatre's family play "AniNgu's Family", a vibrant stage production that combines music, visual art, and dance. With a heartwarming theme of familial love, the play encourages children to embark on a bold and imaginative life adventure, learning about kindness, courage, and creativity. Following this is the Children's Musical Theatre Workshop curated by SanDianShui Production, offering courses in singing, dancing, and acting. Noise

Printing Studio presents a boundary-crossing performance series under the themes of "Understanding the World, Organizing Sound, and Equality & Inclusion." Collaborating groups such as Herbal Healer MONAGONA, PerspecMves, and Raw Material Sound Installation use sound as a medium to merge diverse elements and create new auditory experiences—breaking limitations and opening new perspectives in sound art. The IF Children's Theatre Company returns with "The Classroom Chaos", continuing the fun-filled Detective Pig series. This lighthearted mystery is designed for children of all ages to enjoy with their parents while solving clues together.

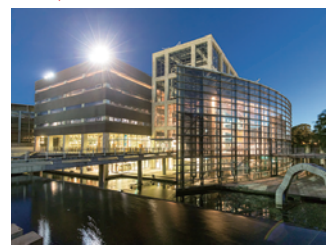
