Sensory Device OFF/ON — Hyper-Sensory Image Experience Exhibition

In the relentless rhythm of daily life saturated with streams of images and sound signals, the body's senses often slip into standby mode, and responses to external stimuli gradually become blurred.

Sensory Device OFF/ON — Hyper-Sensory Image Experience Exhibition invites visitors to reactivate their senses, to observe how images, sounds, and the language of social media shape perception and selfhood, and to explore how sensations in the digital environment are amplified, formatted, computed, and constructed.

The exhibition brings together eight creative teams and groups of artists, spanning moving images, sound, interactive technology, and social culture. Visitors journey through four floors of exhibition space, progressing through stages such as “Logging into the Boundary of Virtual and Real,” “Rebooting Sensory Systems,” “Decoding Emotional Signals,” and “Computing Identity Modules.” In doing so, they experience the

process of receiving signals, expressing emotions, and shaping the self.

The journey begins with Hsieh Hsin-Ni's Here-Now-Position: Past, Present, Present, which reflects on the evolution of media from Showa-era televisions and CRT screens to contemporary displays, re-examining the dynamics of seeing and being seen. After the sensory reboot, Chen Yu-Jung's Spatial Algorithm – Flowing Boundaries transforms environmental data such as temperature, sound, and wind speed into real-time visuals and audio, immersing visitors in a flow of information that shapes perception. Designer Huang Yu-Wen and photographer Chen Kai-Yu's Fuzhong ASMR returns to the pure dimension of listening, constructing a journey of urban sounds such as streets, markets, and alleys without musical accompaniment. In a semi-enclosed space of document boxes, visitors listen quietly, as if leafing through an auditory archive of city and body, reconnecting with the sonic

textures of daily life. Finally, Wu Hsiu-Ming's Rainbow Stage analyzes visitors' voice data, translating sound into dynamic color imagery, where each utterance generates a unique visual scene.

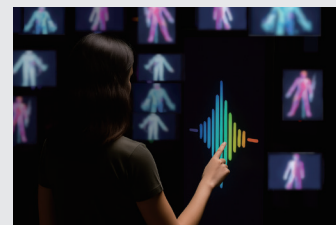
In the context of social media, emotions are swiftly translated into emojis, memes, and stickers—all forms of visual language. Social Lexicon Playground presents the diversity and limitations of these image-based expressions through interactive games. Animator Lin Li's Emo Collection employs emoji as building blocks for a puzzle-like future language world, symbolizing an era where communication and emotion become increasingly de-textualized and visually diverse.

The exhibition concludes by addressing how social platforms and algorithms participate in the shaping of identity. Yangchunmian Research Lab's Internet-Labeling Me publicly displays the artist's selfies and search history, inviting visitors to engage in labeling practices and reflect on how the “self” is defined and simplified in the digital era. Wu Hsiu-Ming's C9-3 Audition Room, inspired by Andy Warhol's concept of screen tests, creates a virtual stage where visitors can freely perform. Voices and images are



processed in real time, generating new identity forms and revealing the multiplicity and fluidity of identity in digital environments.

Sensory Device OFF/ON – Hyper-Sensory Image Experience Exhibition is a profound journey into digital sensation. In a world engulfed by signals, the exhibition offers a space where the senses can be temporarily “rebooted,” evoking new reflections on perception, emotion, and identity. A series of weekend events will also accompany the exhibition. We welcome all those interested in digital culture and contemporary art to join us at Fuzhong 15—open your sensory device and step into a multi-layered arena woven from sounds and images.

Talking Stones : The Origins and Stories of Rocks Special Exhibition

Stones are not only ubiquitous in our daily lives but have also profoundly shaped human civilization. The process of understanding stones, much like our study of plants and animals, has been essential for humans to comprehend the world's appearance and formative mechanisms. Through stones, we can even retrace human history or seek connections between the inner self and the external world. From every perspective, stones have always been vital mediators in humanity's exploration of the world and the advancement of civilization. To help the public understand the scientific differences between “stones” and “rocks,” and to appreciate the stories hidden within

the small stones found in daily life, this exhibition presents more than 120 precious mineral specimens. The collections include loans from the Japan Central Earthquake Fault Museum and the Iwami Ginzan Silver Mine World Heritage Center, as well as pieces from the National Taiwan Museum, the National Museum of Natural Science, the National Museum of Prehistory, the Taiwan Gemological Association, and many private collectors.

On the opening afternoon, curators from both Taiwan and Japan will hold a special salon discussion on the exhibition's theme, and the public is warmly invited to attend.

“Moonlight Weaving Love” Series

The National Historic Site Lin Family Mansion & Garden presents its nighttime projection mapping show. With blessings from the deities of Taipei Xia-Hai City God Temple and the historic pavilions of the Lin Mansion as the backdrop, the event combines history, culture, and digital art into an evening experience centered on the theme of love.

Daytime activities feature Yue Lao folk rituals, artistic performances, and handicraft workshops in the historic spaces of the mansion, offering couples, friends, and families the chance to create joyful memories among the garden's pavilions. At night, the projection mapping show transforms the historic Laiqing Pavilion,

inspired by the legendary love story of the Cowherd and the Weaver Girl, immersing visitors in a romantic journey of light and shadow. Special dance performances by the Contemporary Legend Theatre will further weave together live performance and visual art. An interactive light experience invites audiences to create personalized images on their mobile phones and instantly project them onto the historic architecture, merging with the light show to craft their own unique love story.

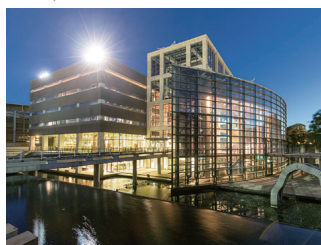

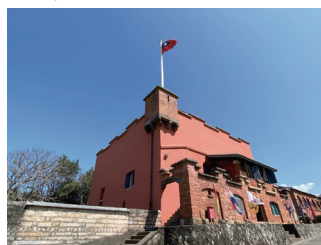
