Shining New Taipei — 1314 Cross-River Fireworks

New Taipei City's New Year's Eve celebration, "Shining New Taipei – 1314 Cross-River Fireworks," will take place on the night of December 31, 2025, spanning Tamsui Fisherman's Wharf, Customs Wharf, and Bali Left Bank Park. The festivities begin at 4:30 PM, with simultaneous interactive performances in Tamsui and Bali. During the day, visitors can explore Tamsui's historic sites, cycle along the Bali Left Bank, or enjoy ferry tours, and at night experience fireworks paired with music.

This year's cross-river fireworks show will launch at 8:26 PM, and will include 13 minutes and 14 seconds of dazzling fireworks illustrating the romantic theme of

"forever" (一生一世).

The event features over 12 groups of artists from Taiwan and abroad, including rising idols performing across two stages.

At midnight, the French artistic fireworks team will present the spectacular 1314 Cross-River Fireworks above Danjiang Bridge. After the show, Korean superstar Hwasa will deliver the grand finale on the Tamsui stage, while Japanese singer-songwriter Ai Higuchi will welcome audiences into 2026 on the Bali stage.

Traffic control will be implemented in the afternoon. Visitors are encouraged to plan ahead and use public transportation to gather under the brightest night sky and welcome a hopeful 2026 together.

To Manifest an End —LI Ying-Jung Solo Exhibition

"Only in the face of death does a being become fully what it is."

—Martin Heidegger

If, as Heidegger suggests, only by confronting death can we perceive the essence of existence, then perhaps the apocalypse is the ultimate self-manifestation of civilization itself.

In the exhibition Manifestation Apocalypse, we gaze not merely upon destruction, but treat it as a coordinate for reflecting on existence, perception, and the architecture of the senses.

This exhibition does not depict ruins, but rather traces how the desire for apocalypse gradually manifests within the contemporary human psyche.

It invites viewers to sense that an ending is quietly unfolding. Here, the apocalypse is no longer a single terminus, but a series of calm, low-frequency, and silent shifts in perception—a background process, like data slowly being overwritten in the cloud. Manifestation Apocalypse is not born of humankind's love for destruction, but of our inability to bear an infinitely prolonged present.

This exhibition is not a question of why things end, but how.

It does not yearn for the end of the world—it merely reveals how, deep within our subconscious, we have already come to see the end as a form of liberation.
