“Shulin Arts Center” trial-run starting

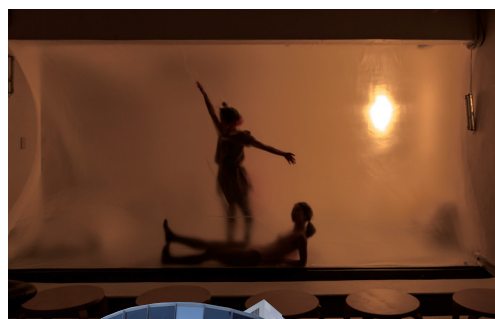

Three Performances, new experiences

Water Reflection Dance Ensemble Will present “Floral”, an ensemble inspired by the poems of contemporary Taiwanese female poets. It is a dialogue between poetry and various forms of life. Lo Shi-jong, winner of the Hakka Golden Melody Award, composed the spiritual soundtrack. “Baed Time” by Myan Myan Studio explores the issues of live, death and existence. The ensemble, through the interaction of little girls' lovely dolls in a sleepless night, reflects the incurable trauma of life. Acrobat Taiwan's “Desire to Fly” is a heartwarming musical full of positive energy. It will take audience into the imaginative world of physical and mentally impaired children.

In addition, the Center invites Mr Yes the clown to specifically design “Summer in Shulin NOW-Introduction to Theater” for children. The children will be able to engage with the theatrical space through the lively yet funny instruction of Mr Yes. “Listen to the bodily rhythm” lecture presented by Water Reflection Dance Ensemble will introduce the basic knowledge of dance. The symphony of fabric

Amongst the Taiwanese indigenous communities, the Atayal people are known for their weaving skills. Their traditional costumes are mostly woven with ramie, then interwoven with colored wool or with shell decoration. The costumes includes top, vest, kerchief, skirt and headdress. Colors vary from region to region.
