In May, our two special exhibitions introduce



the key events of Tamsui's history, including the establishment of the Tamsui Port and Customs in 1862, and the arrival of George Mackay in 1872. Within this ten-year period, Tamsui transformed into an international port and the destination of countless merchant ships. This led to the collision and exchange of different cultures, paying the way for the unique cultural landscape of the Tamsui Port.

Tamsui Port

In May, we launch "Passing the Hurdles! Celebrating 160 years of Tamsui Port" Special Exhibition, this is held in Warehouse C of the Tamsui Customs Wharf, we have transformed all historical events into actual onsite hurdles. Here, you will meet John Todd, the late nineteenth-century British businessman and Mackay. You are invited to join their team and explore the histories of Tamsui Port. This exhibition consists of three missions: will take on the role of a foreign businessman

travelling to Taiwan. Here, you will be asked to decode all the custom procedures, paving your way into a millionaire. Next, in "Decoding Foreign Trade," you need to learn about the hidden roles of business and trades in Taiwan. You have to carefully consider






