### 2023 New Taipei City Multicultural Festival

This year, our Festival, titled “RE-EARTHING,” will be all about environment, food and culture. Through our programs, we encourage you to not only explore the multilayered local culture of New Taipei City, but also have the opportunity to express and share different cultural identifies, we invite you to be part of our intercultural communication and integration.

#### Main Program: Sensing Multiculturalism

On March 26th, we will launch our main program at the 823 Memorial Park, with its rich greenery and natural scenery, the park is an oasis in our urban jungle. It is an ideal environment for everyone to open up their senses and reconnect with Mother

### The 2023 Sanzhi Cherry Blossom Season

Spring has arrived and it is time to pay her a visit! Sanzhi’s cherry blossoms are the first to know, as they transform into pink-petal blossoms to welcome every visitor. In this season, drivers along Qingshan and Dahu Roads, Freeway No. 101, Freeways North No. 7, 9 and 11 will get to enjoy a spectacle of blooming cherries.

The Sansheng Trail here is a walkway that embodies the idea of “Productivity,” “Livability” and “Environment.” Along the roadside, the cherries bloom proudly and embellish the trail with their unique beauty and grace, turning the Trail into a hotspot to appreciate the cherry blossom. By the roadside, our hope and farmer’s markets, showcasing high-quality souvenirs and fresh

While appreciating the cherry blossom, why not pay the nearby Xinghua Station and be immersed in its aura as a former military base? Now, our local artists and young farmers have collaborated to turn the site into an art center, combining arts and village culture. They incorporate natural elements into the artistic environment, transforming the site into a unique Sanzhi landmark. Here, we will show you how we can convert farming into a form of artistic expression.



### Old Shops in Xindian- A Story

For this exhibition, we focus on 21 participating local shops which have been operating for more than 50 years. They are the historic fabric of the local settlement and daily life, having grown and prospered during the heydays of the railway. In the exhibition, we utilize the traditional objects and projects of these shops to recreate their unique texture and flavor. Our exhibition display and programs are another highlight. We have prepared the molds for making cakes, allowing our visitors to learn and enjoy the creation of traditional cakes. What’s more, we are inviting you to pay these local shops a visit, listening to the stories of our elders, and explore our history through this event.

We have prepared a series of walking tours around our historic streets, inviting you to read

the traditional texture of our district on the road. Taking our “Shopping Joy on Guangming Street” as an example, you will develop in-depth knowledge of all shops on the street and visit a wide range of traditional businesses, ranging from grain store, bridal shop, car mechanics and clinic. Strolling along Xindian Road, you will have the opportunity to visit a variety of old and recent shops. The road will take you all the way to Ankeng, which is flavored by the fragrance of tea leaves.
