KICK OFF! New Taipei City Art Museum Park now open!

Sanying, located in the Yingge District, is the reclaimed land that is the confluence of the Yingge and Dahan Rivers. It is also the location of the New Taipei City Art Museum (NTCAM). Our ultimate goal is to become a “museum for all the people,” we are focused on developing the arts and culture of the entire city, making arts a part of everyone’s life. Our museum is dedicated to being a place for lifelong learning and social integration.

From April 15th, NTCAM will open up a few sections for public access, including the park and outdoor area, the ground-level Creative Cluster and The Pavilion. In addition, we will regularly invite curators and artists for residencies and art projects, and invite them to share their ideas on “Participation and Collaboration,” which is the warm up for our upcoming official opening.

Regular Art Programs

We have invited 17 teams of cross-disciplinary artists to reside in the ground-level Creative Cluster, to promote their Making Circle exhibition. This exhibition is a collaborative project with visitors and focused on the unique features of New Taipei City, aiming to develop a new type of artistic community. “New Friends,” located in The Pavilion is a digital art exhibition that will interact with you, allowing you to be fully immersed in the experience.

What’s more, our park will showcase the public art displays in the Sanying Arts Space. All new public artworks will be open to visitors for the first time!

Special programs to celebrate our opening

Starting from April 15th, we will launch a series of special programs and events to



celebrate the opening of NTCAM Park for three weekends in a row. We invite you to become NTCAM’s friend and cultivate your relationship with us through our art nature and recreational activities that are held in the Museum’s park.

Hello, NTCAM: Programs for the first week will take place on April 15th and 16th. Our “diverse and cross-disciplinary” concert is a lawn musical party for all. We have an all-star team to bring dazzling crossover performances, including Julia Peng, Henry Hsu, Jia Jia, Ann, Won Fu as well as Taipei Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra. Several feature stores will set up stands at the venue. You will have the opportunity to win the “opening-special rice dumplings” gift.

Mambo Vibes: Programs for the second week are scheduled on April 22nd and 23rd. With the guidance of our experts, you will have the chance to decode the hidden secrets



in our park. Altogether we will explore 9 sets of public artworks and installations made by artists Tsai-Chien Lee, Teh-I Chu, Tai-Chun Chou, Atelier Hui-Kan, Yenting Hsu, Yu-Chiao Yang, Shuen-Long Lin, Chien-Fu Wu, Wen-Yi Kung and Hsuan-Yu Shih.

Sun Table: Programs for the third week will be launched on April 29th and 30th. We bring our focus to community gatherings and organize a multifaceted food program, this includes the Sunny Theater, the Earth Gallery, collaborative nutrient stations and food market, which supplies are directly provided by environmentally friendly businesses. We invite you to experience the land and nature, enjoy a meal made with others and be part of the landmark of the prominent NTCAM collaborative program. We ask you to eat and learn with us under the sunlight, renewing your connections with Mother Earth.

Open Day at Hobe Elementary School Auditorium

Our heritage building has a funny face! Hobe Elementary School Auditorium just likes a gentle grandad with white eyebrows and beard. Since the Japanese Era, education in Tamsui has progressed under his watch. In celebration of its centenary this year, we will reopen the School Hall for the new semester in April!

The Schoil was Tamsui’s only elementary school in the early phase of Japanese Era. The Auditorium, built in 1923, is the only surviving building on the former school site, which experienced a series of replanting, alteration and demolition work. The building has witnessed the history and development of Tamsui’s elementary education under the Japanese rule. It is a public school building constructed with red brick, popular at its

time. The façade features arches and pilasters, punctured by round-arch window openings and rectangular timber doors, demonstrating elements of both Japanese and European architectural flavor. The Hall is located on the hilltop with a broad view to the city, quietly observing the changes and development of the urban landscape beneath.

The reopened Hobe Elementary School Auditorium will comprise the following three programs, including “Curiosity Box of the past,” “A typical school day” and “Fun after school.” Tamsui Historical Museum will also launch a series of related programs. Please join us to appreciate the newly conserved Hobe Elementary School Auditorium.
