#### 2023 New Taipei Austronesian Cultural Festival

The Austronesian language family is the July 29th and 30th. With the theme of most widely distributed language family in the world, stretching from Easter Island in the east to Madagascar in the west, and reaching as far south as New Zealand, with Taiwan being its northernmost point.
