### “New Ground”—2023 New Taipei City Art Festival

The 2023 New Taipei City Art Festival "New Ground" begins at the New Taipei Art Corridor in Sanxia District, in coordination with the rich history, industry, and cultural heritage of the area. From the New Taipei City Art Museum to the New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum, it symbolizes a new ground where industry meets aesthetics. "New Ground" is an attitude, encompassing inclusiveness, collaboration, and recognition. It extracts vitality from the land, awakening the energy of local art and craftsmanship, and opening up the infinite imagination of this



"New Ground." The New Taipei City Art Festival consists of an opening ceremony, visual arts, performing arts, and special events, all interconnected with the dome art space of the New Taipei City Art Museum, the art district, and the New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum, presenting four distinctive exhibitions. This art festival brings together domestic and international artists and 28 performance groups, showcasing 13 visual arts works and 92 performing arts works. From July 1st to July 16th, over three consecutive weekends, in addition to mobile performances, there will be vibrant marketplaces and themed activities with a strong New Taipei flavor, encouraging the audience to become part of the festive new energy.

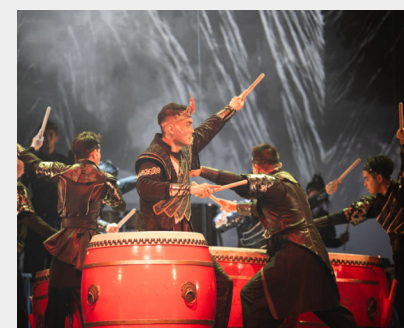
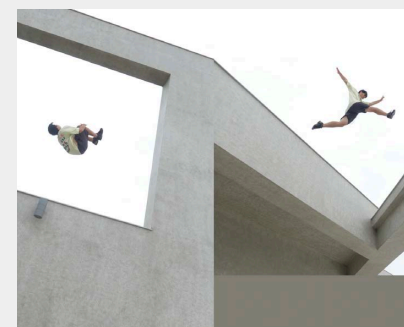

### 2023 New Taipei Austronesian Cultural Festival

The Austronesian language family is the most widely distributed language family in the world, stretching from Easter Island in the east to Madagascar in the west, and reaching as far south as New Zealand, with Taiwan being its northernmost point. Due to its extensive distribution, the Austronesian language family possesses diverse cultural elements, encompassing various aspects of life such as food, clothing, shelter, transportation, rituals, and music. Among these cultural aspects, rituals hold the deepest significance.

To promote Taiwan's Austronesian culture, the Shihshanhang Museum of Archaeology in New Taipei City is hosting the "2023 New Taipei Austronesian Cultural Festival" on

July 29th and 30th. With the theme of "Austronesian Etiquette," the festival aims to allow the public to experience Austronesian ritual activities and learn about ceremonial objects, and it will showcase the essence of Austronesian culture by focusing on "coming of age" ceremonies. The event includes four main thematic activities: dance performances, skill experiences, a cultural and creative market, and a culinary feast, with a total of 40 booths and 20 performances. The festival will run from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM, and free shuttle services will be provided. We invite you to come and experience the vibrant and unique charm of Austronesian culture, and gain insights into the etiquette and rituals of the Austronesian peoples.

### My Room - Joint Exhibition of Female Artists

The diverse appearances of the ceramic creations of modern female artists express their creative spirits and their thoughts regarding inner consciousness, lifestyle flavors, and consumer culture. The exhibition title draws inspiration from Virginia Woolf's essay "A Room of One's Own," written nearly a century ago, symbolizing women's pursuit of economic independence and the authority to assert themselves while enjoying undisturbed mental space. This exhibition showcases 18 ceramic artworks by female artists from the collection of the Yingge Ceramics Museum, displaying the voices of female artists from both domestic and international contexts as they convey their observations and reflections on their

environments through artistic creations. The exhibition also explores themes related to the ever-vibrant natural world and contemplation on life, which are often focal points for female artists' creations. Barbara Nanning's "Ode to the Sea" portrays the surging vitality of the ocean through its sculptural form. Deborah Sigel's "Flower" captures the beauty of flowers as they freeze in time. Liu Xi's "The Other Shore" raises questions about life, stating that becoming a free individual who transcends societal limitations is akin to reaching the other shore.

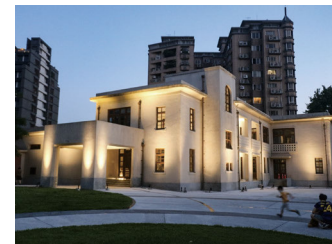
