### 2023 New Taipei City Children's Art Festival — Monster Paradise

The exciting New Taipei City Children's Art Festival will be held from August 5th to 13th! This year's theme is "Monster Paradise," creating a vibrant and colorful world of monsters. It will feature a variety of activities, including performances, art installations, interactive experiences, markets, and design participation. The main venues for the Monster Paradise are the New Taipei City Civic Plaza, City Hall, the pedestrian area of Chongqing Road in Banqiao District, and various art centers managed by the Cultural Bureau.

In addition, the seven major art and cultural venues in New Taipei City will also launch the "Colorful Museum" series as exclusive activities for the Children's Art Festival.

The "Fantasy Stage" offers daily special performances full of music, dance, drama, and audio-visual magic, inviting children to join in the enchanting charm of the performances. The performances will run from August 5th to August 13th, and the closing performance will

be "Dancing with Cloud Gate," presented by Cloud Gate Dance Theatre to celebrate its 50th anniversary, allowing children and adults to dance together in close proximity to the world of dance. This year, a colorful mini "Bubble Driving Class" will be created in the "Adventure Zone," featuring different challenging activities designed for children of different age groups, such as interactive driver training cars, allowing children to learn about the importance of traffic safety through play. Furthermore, the Civic Plaza will be filled with various experiential and art installations, including the "Colorful Garden" with monster-themed murals and an iris flower zoo. The plaza will be transformed into a vibrant and colorful space. On weekends, the Civic Plaza will host the "Little Boss Market," inviting children to design their own shop signs and experience being a shop owner. The City Hall will feature the "Magical World," an experiential installation of technology art, allowing people to immerse

themselves in a rich world of colors. A "Fantasy Cinema" has also been set up, featuring exciting animated films screened at regular intervals. The festival also includes the "Circus Zone," which will present circus performances on two weekends, creating a colorful and playful circus carnival.

Other venues such as the New Taipei City Arts Center, with a focus on "Children's Art," will take the theme of "Market Culture" as a starting point, leading visitors from ancient to modern markets, creating a monster-themed market paradise! The exhibition, which runs from July 24th to August 27th, is divided into three major areas. The first area presents the history and cultural aspects of markets through custom paintings depicting market scenes from different eras. The second area focuses on Taiwan's classic "Traditional Market" and "Night Market," allowing children to make their own products and showcase their vision of markets. The third area brings common game booths from markets into the exhibition hall, allowing everyone to challenge themselves!

The Xinzhuang Cultural Arts Center is presenting the "Hi-Sen! Summer Childhood Special Exhibition," featuring three forest-themed areas of drums, paper cutting,



and spinning tops, with exhibits transformed into adorable monster mascots. The Xinban Art Gallery, in collaboration with other units, ing present "Hi! Get to Know My Colorful World," showcasing the works of Star Children and artists with disabilities, touching viewers' hearts through their colorful visual expressions.

The exhibition, which combines the New Taipei City Children's Art Festival's monster IP, offers various educational outreach programs to inspire children's unlimited creativity and imagination.

The New Taipei City Beautiful Yong'an Art Center is hosting the "Childhood Story Art Quilting Exhibition," curated by Lin Hsin-chen's Fiber Art Studio, showcasing hand-sewn art quilts. The exhibition runs from July 21<sup>st</sup> to August 30<sup>th</sup>.

### The "Just FUN New Taipei" street culture festival in 2023 will ignite a wave of creativity this summer!

The grand "Just FUN New Taipei" street culture festival in 2023 will be held on August 19th, 20th, 26th, and 27th at the Banqiao Fuzhong Square! It includes highly iconic events such as the "MADSTREET" rap battle, the "Ink Road" international graffiti competition, and the "New Taipei FUN Street" dance competition.

The "Just FUN New Taipei" street culture festival brings together four elements: rap, graffiti, street art, and street dance. It features the "Back 2 Basics" DJ scratching zone to rediscover the origins of rap, the "Style Writing" spray painting and technology graffiti zone, the "Soulful Dance Zone" street dance area, and the "Cross The Line" skateboard experience zone! This year, 120

groups of artists have been invited to showcase their talents in stunts, magic, clown acts, balloon sculptures, and street art creations. The festival also includes the "Hustle Hard" street market, featuring American-style food trucks and a 3.9-meter-tall pink rabbit installation. The finale of the event is the "Burn Da Mic" hip-hop concert, featuring six rap teams ranging from rising stars like Multiverse and Gummy B to award-winning artists like Xiong Zai, leading everyone into the world of music. Let's integrate street art into local life!

### Air Force Sanchongyi Village Opening Exhibition: Eternal Affection, Unceasing Village Sounds

In August of this year, the military dependents' village of Sanchongyi Village, a unique artillery base in the northern region with a history of 69 years, will meet everyone with a brand new look! Apart from the famous military dependents' village delicacies such as sauerkraut pork hot pot and barbecue restaurants, the renowned Banqiao beef noodle shop "Yin Wei" will also open a branch here. In addition to the culinary delights, there will be bookstores, guesthouses, theaters, and handicraft workshops, inviting us to experience the new Air Force military dependents' village. The exhibition will feature a solo exhibition by Japanese artist Akinori Oishi, who was awarded the prestigious MLIA Emerging

Artist Award in France. Assistant Professor Lu Yin-chao will serve as the curator, leading a team of students to organize the exhibition. Assistant Professor Lu Yin-chao has participated in the preservation movement of the Sanchongyi Village and this exhibition will guide us in understanding the historical significance of Sanchong and allow us to engage in immersive experiences in the military dependents' village kitchen. Furthermore, we will explore the architectural features of Sanchongyi Village and share the memories of its residents, with the aim of fostering connections between the Sanchong area, Taiwan, and international communities, and inspiring a different kind of inclusiveness, communication, and potential.
