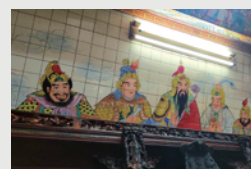

#### 2024 Exploring New Taipei: A Local Mapping Journey

Since its inception in 2021, "Crossing New Taipei" has retrospectively examined the development of art in New Taipei from an art history perspective. This year, it focuses on "Mapping the Locale," with five events organized in the form of dialogues, walks, performances, screenings, and exhibitions. On May 4th, under the theme "Reimagining Locality: Folk Art · Contemporary Collection", contemporary perceptions and directions in folk art will be explored. On May 11th, the theme will be "Local Legends: Stories as Paths to Understanding Locality", and the audience will listen to local legends, story texts, and historical events from different regions. The activity will include narration and analysis of folk tales such as Yingge Stone and Stone Horse, reflecting the zeitgeist and social context through

these folk stories. The theme for May 18th is "Decorative Landscapes: Exploring Architecture Through Tiles", and the public will be led through different eras of buildings in Tamsui, exploring various types of tiles in decorative architectural spaces. On May 19th, "Tracing the Wilderness: Contemporary Pursuits of Indigenous Traces" will include a visit to the Yufeng Coal Mine, witnessing the forced migration of the Tayal tribe's Dabao community and the development history of the Sanxia coal mining industry. On May 26th, "Redrawing Borders: Practicing with the Sea and River as Domains" features environmental art education teams sharing practical cases in Gongliao's Magang Fishing Village and Pinglin's Beishi Creek.

#### The Exhibition of Nightingale of the Mine

Jinguashi was once the largest precious metal mine in East Asia, with nearly 20,000 residents during its peak mining period. Due to the high population and hazardous mining work, hospitals became vital facilities in the mine. In the 1900s, mining companies established medical offices, and by the 1930s, after renovations by the Japanese mining corporation, these offices evolved into a well-equipped hospital with modern medical facilities. Its comprehensive services attracted patients from surrounding areas. After the war, the Jinguashi Hospital was managed by Taiwan Metal Mining Corporation, undergoing renovations and equipment upgrades to provide enhanced medical services. However,

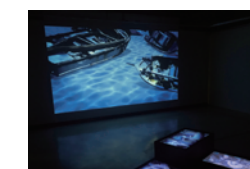

#### The All-Seeing Eye - 2024 Mobile Eye International Dynamic Media Art Festival

The exhibition 《The All-Seeing Eye - 2024 Mobile Eye International Dynamic Media Art Festival》 displays various forms of dynamic image art, including video installations, audio-visual art, interactive installations, and expanded cinema. Guided by artists' profound interpretations of contemporary social phenomena, it leads the audience to explore how visual imagery influences life, thought, information, and politics. The curatorial theme of this year involves an exploration of the phenomenon of mobile communication in image media, reflecting on humanity's high reliance on visual perception in contemporary social contexts. It delves into the visual intentions of image media, revealing the ideological aspects of elements ranging from

#### Craftsmanship and Memories Carried on Shoulders - Exhibition of Kiri from the Atayal Tribe

The Atayal tribe resides in the mountainous areas of central and northern Taiwan, including in various townships of New Taipei City, Taoyuan City, Hsinchu County, Miaoli County, Taichung City, Nantou County, and Yilan County. To showcase the traditional craftsmanship and culture of the Atayal tribe, this exhibition will feature the stories of two kiri (back baskets) from the Wulai Atayal Museum's collection. In collaboration with the Indigenous Affairs Commission of the Taichung City Government, it will also include field research reports on kiri from the Shuangqi Atayal tribe in Taichung, along with kiri made by elders at the Wulai Cultural Health Station. This provides an opportunity for the public to delve into the skills and stories embedded in

these back baskets and experience their charm alongside enthusiasts of bamboo weaving. Through this collaborative effort of museums and local connections, it is hoped that "Craftsmanship and Memories Carried on Shoulders - Exhibition of Kiri from the Atayal Tribe" can open a window for the public to understand the diverse cultures of Taiwan's indigenous peoples, sparking deeper interest and exploration into Atayal culture. In addition to the exhibition, the Wulai Atayal Museum offers special exhibition check-in gift activities, cultural guided tours, and bamboo weaving craft DIY experiences. 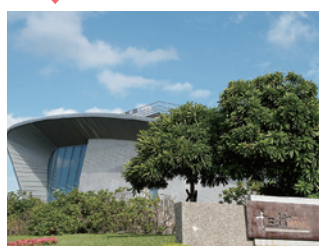
