2025 New Taipei Drum Arts Festival

The 2025 New Taipei Drum Arts Festival extends from June 21 to June 29, featuring touring performances in Xinzhuang, Luzhou, Tucheng, and Shuangxi. The public is invited to join in and enjoy the lively drumming showcases. This year's theme, "Beating in Celebration (擊慶)," uses earth-shaking drum sounds to unite local cultural and artistic energy, creating a shared resonance throughout New Taipei. Drums, central in traditional theater and temple festivals, carry powerful, grounding energy, and local drum-making has thrived alongside this culture. Since its 2007 launch, the festival has toured various districts, promoting drumming arts and bringing cultural

events to local communities.

The festival opens June 21 at Xinzhuang Sports Park Sunny Lawn, with a local school drum team and the acclaimed U-Theatre. This year's lineup includes Yugu Workshop & Kobayashi Yoshitaka, Chong-Chi Workshop, Taipei Extreme Drums, Ouyang Hui-Chen Dance Company, and more, presenting diverse global drumming styles. Su Rui-Yung + Taiwan Man-Yi and the Body Sound Percussion Group will explore body percussion and the expressive link between movement and sound. Mali Bali Cultural and Arts Group will blend Taroko indigenous instruments with drumming for a unique, creative show.

The 15th New Taipei City Literature Awards (2025) are now open for submissions!

The 15th New Taipei City Literature Awards, which have the theme "New Taipei Genesis," are open for submissions until July 15 in five categories: prose, poetry, short fiction, picture book stories, and new immigrant picture-text creations. The total prize pool is NT\$1.31 million! This year's theme encourages people to draw inspiration from daily life and write their own stories, allowing creativity to flourish like the branches of a literary tree unique to this city. The competition is open to all nationalities; entries must be written in Chinese. The New Immigrant Picture-Text Creation category centers on the theme "My Own Room," reflecting the diverse stories of

people who have migrated to and now live in New Taipei. Participants are invited to submit a 100–500 word Chinese narrative with accompanying images. In addition, the Literature Awards will feature promotional events in June. In early June, Yang Tzu-Wei, winner of the Picture Book Story category at the 13th Literature Awards, will join Jo Yen-Tung, Associate Editor-in-Chief at Linking Publishing's Children's Books, for a talk on the creative and practical process of developing a picture book. In mid-June, poets Chen Fan-Chi and Hsu Pei-Fen will lead poetry reading and writing sessions. All promotional events are free and open to anyone interested in literature!



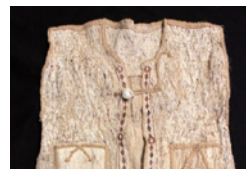

Threads of Austronesia – Ancient Austronesian Clothing Exhibition

Threads of Austronesia – Ancient Austronesian Clothing Exhibition focuses on the Austronesian peoples, showcasing the evolution of clothing traditions from ancient techniques such as barkcloth making and weaving to modern craft revival. The featured material, bark, has a long history of use among Austronesian communities. Barkcloth is known for its durability and breathability, making it an ideal fabric for tropical climates. Aside from its use in clothing, barkcloth is also an indispensable part of daily life for many Oceanic communities. It plays diverse roles in home decor, personal adornment, artistic expression, and ceremonial rituals. For instance, during

the 2021 Tokyo Olympics opening ceremony, the representative of the Kingdom of Tonga—an Austronesian nation in Oceania—wore a beautifully crafted traditional barkcloth garment, highlighting its cultural significance. Through the diverse clothing techniques of Austronesian cultures, this exhibition offers a renewed understanding of the meanings woven into their garments. It also invites us to reflect on the ancient wisdom of sustainable living—drawing from nature and returning to nature.
