Cover Story



The New Taipei Street School is back for its 2nd year!

Last summer, the New Taipei Street School (School of the Street) officially launched, becoming a landmark event celebrating New Taipei's vibrant multicultural street culture.

This year, we're back—stronger and more exciting than ever! Extending from June 27 to September 21, the 2nd edition centers around Fuzhong 15, featuring immersive exhibitions and trendy general street culture courses. In August, we'll join forces with top street dance competitions, rappers, and DJs to throw the most exciting campus-style street party at Fuzhong Plaza—where the pulse of the city meets the raw energy of the streets.

The event features three themed exhibition areas that offer a deep dive into New Taipei's street culture:

On the 3rd floor, the "Street People" zone, in collaboration with YouTube channel HahaTai (1M+ subscribers), features interview with local creators and showcases personal items that tell their stories. The space also features a Dance Machine choreographed by Nike and

Huang Jian—renowned figures in Taiwan's dance scene—where visitors can step up and experience street dance firsthand.

The 4th floor's "Hip-Hop Ground" focuses on the birthplace of street culture, mapping street hotspots from alleyways to bridges across New Taipei. A Graffiti Room invites both beginners and seasoned artists to freely create. On July 12, August 9, and September 13, the underground freestyle event Hi! POP Freestyle Party will be recreated inside the exhibition space, delivering raw hip-hop energy straight to the audience.

On the 5th floor, the "Future Lab" is an experimental space that encourages interaction. Visitors can submit lyrics, post dreams on the Wish Wall, and use the custom photo booth to create a Street School student ID. This is a space with no right answers—just your voice helping shape the future of street culture.

On the 1st floor, the Campus Radio Room

hosts podcast recordings by real street creators, offering insider perspectives and untold stories from the community.

Starting in July, Weekend Exclusive Classes will be held every Saturday afternoon. From dance and rap to DJing and graffiti, street artists will teach participants the coolest skills in the culture in a fun and accessible way. Whether you're a curious beginner or a passionate fan, there's something for everyone to learn and enjoy.

To complement the program, Fuzhong 15 features extended spaces: a Fingerboard Skatepark on the 2nd floor and the "Respect! Cool Life" themed film series in the basement theater—offering immersive experiences from hands-on fun to cinematic street storytelling.

The energy peaks in August with massive outdoor events. On August 2–3, the 2025 New Taipei International Street Dance Competition kicks off at Banqiao Stadium. Then, on August 16–17, the Street Party takes over Fuzhong Plaza with a high-energy lineup. In addition to the returning MADSTREET Rap Battle and Ink Walker Graffiti Contest, this year's main stage features:

Forty (from The Rappers 2), OG rapper Dantou, rising star Quanzo, high-impact crew



Multiverse, and the melodic trap duo Night Only. The event also includes hands-on street experience booths, performances, and interactive games—filling the summer plaza with rhythm, creativity, and non-stop excitement. Whether you're there to perform, create, or just soak it all in—this summer, the street is your classroom, and the city is your canvas. Come learn, play, and live street culture to the fullest!

Secret Passage No. 34 – A Collective Summer Exhibition: A Journey Through Imagination and the Soul

In the summer of 2025, eleven creators will guide you down a path—the secret passage known as "No. 34"—toward a broader, more diverse, and more deeply creative sky.

"Secret Passage No. 34" is a summer group exhibition jointly curated by eleven artists. The works on display span a wide range of media, including acrylic, watercolor, oil paint, crayon, colored pencil, gouache, digital watercolor, ink collage, color sticks, and three-dimensional forms. Each piece represents a fragment of the creator's soul.

The exhibition is organized into zones for each artist, showcasing their works alongside personal sketches and 3D pieces, highlighting the unique style and creative perspective of each participant. During the

exhibition period, a number of workshops will also be held, inviting visitors to experience hands-on creation using different materials. Through these activities, we hope viewers won't just admire the art, but will truly feel the joy of creating.

We invite you to step into Secret Passage No. 34, where we meet on the canvas and see one another's landscapes through the act of creation.

Cultural Heritage Unboxed: Summer Series at the Lin Family Mansion and Garden

This summer, Lin Family Mansion and Garden in Banqiao presents its annual cultural series, "Cultural Heritage Unboxed," running from July 12 to September 29. The event features a rich blend of exhibitions, lectures, guided tours, and hands-on craft workshops that visitors of all ages are invited to participate in.

For the first time, a themed exhibition will be introduced, centered on the Lin Ben Yuan Family Mansion, a national historic site. The exhibit highlights three major traditional crafts—wood carving, cut-and-paste clay sculpture, and decorative lattice windows—showcasing the refined techniques and artistic wisdom of traditional artisans in architectural design and spatial

aesthetics. Eight lecturers and artisans with backgrounds ranging from academic to practical have been invited to participate, offering accessible and engaging insights into architectural beauty and traditional craftsmanship. During the exhibition period, there will be cultural lectures, themed tours, and hands-on craft workshops for adults and for parent-child pairs, allowing visitors not only to appreciate the beauty of cultural heritage, but also to create similar items with their own hands—experiencing the spirit and warmth of traditional crafts.
