New Taipei Museum Cultural Spring Outing—Fun from Before the New Year Holiday to the Lantern Festival

As the Year of the Horse arrives, New Taipei City invites you to begin the new year with a cultural journey. Integrating New Taipei’s arts and cultural venues, five aesthetic corridors, and nearby attractions, a three-phase series of activities is planned—from warm-up events before the Lunar New Year begins, to Spring Festival outings, and a Lantern Festival finale—allowing visitors to enjoy the festivities, collect souvenirs, and take home good fortune.

With its vast landscape stretching from mountains and coastlines to historic sites, contemporary art, and industrial culture, New Taipei City offers unique charms in every district. This cultural spring outing takes the “Five Aesthetic Corridors” as its starting point, inviting the public into museums and city neighborhoods. Through exhibitions, hands-on experiences, and interactive

missions, it creates a Spring Festival journey that combines cultural depth with festive fun. Spring Warm-Up • Starting Before the New Year

As the Spring Festival approaches, warm-up activities begin ahead of time. Before the Lunar New Year, visitors can explore designated cultural venues in New Taipei City, including the Shihshanhang Museum of Archaeology, the Tamsui Historical Museum, the Gold Museum, the Yingge Ceramics Museum, the New Taipei City Art Museum, the Pinglin Tea Museum, and the Lin Family Mansion and Garden—six museums and one historic garden. By completing a designated Spring Festival comment on each venue’s official social media platform, visitors can redeem a limited-edition New Taipei Museum badge at the service counter, obtaining a cultural souvenir for their New Year holiday itinerary before the holiday has even begun.

Full Horsepower, Blessings Aplenty After family reunions on Lunar New Year’s

Eve and the first day of the Lunar New Year, the second day marks the perfect time to go out. From the second to the sixth day of the Lunar New Year, New Taipei museums fully enter spring outing mode. Visitors who find “horse” elements within the museums—such as exhibition works, installations, or key visual designs—and complete a photo task featuring Year of the Horse imagery, or spend NT\$500 or more, can receive one capsule toy token to try their luck at the capsule machine and win a special Year of the Horse New Year gift.

Year of the Horse Spring Outing • Starting from New Taipei Museums

During the Spring Festival, museums across New Taipei offer a wide range of themed activities. The Shihshanhang Museum of Archaeology presents multiple days of parent-child interactive performances; the Gold Museum has New Year-limited stamp-making activities; the Tamsui Historical Museum offers handmade New Year items and Spring Festival couplets; the Yingge Ceramics Museum hosts a series of Spring Festival experiences and clay DIY workshops; the New Taipei City Art Museum features three consecutive days of street performances and local markets; the Pinglin Tea Museum

provides a New Year cinema, bingo games, and a fun horse-racing challenge; and the Lin Family Mansion and Garden presents calligraphy couplet writing, lion dances, and traditional opera performances, bringing a lively festive atmosphere to these historic sites.

“Character Action! Studio Apprenticeship” — Come to Fuzhong 15 and Make Your Own Movie!

What does it feel like to be a director?

At the permanent exhibition “Character Action! Studio Apprenticeship” in the Fuchu 15 Image Lab, a mini film studio designed for children and families features five interactive zones that introduce filmmaking in an intuitive, playful way.

Children can explore every corner of the studio, experiencing roles from directing to editing. Starting at the “Work Desk,” they create their own characters inspired by everyday scenes around Fuchu. In the “Makeup Room,” craft materials bring these characters to life.

Highlights include five miniature sets—four based on local streets and one “Ames Room” that uses optical illusions to create

movie-like effects. While filming with a smartphone, visitors can explore the captivating language of imagery through different shooting angles and compositions. After filming, visitors can head to the editing room to cut and assemble their footage into the story they want to tell. The finished work is then brought to the screening room, where they can sit in front of a large screen and enjoy the debut of their own movie. The exhibition also features a specially designed character-sharing system: characters you create may quietly appear in someone else’s story, while characters made by other children may show up in yours—allowing imaginations to intertwine in a collectively woven visual game.

Sustainable Nature: A Special Exhibition



This exhibition presents a multi-layered dialogue between ceramics and nature. Featuring representative works by past resident artists of the New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum, it explores ecology, memory, and culture through clay and natural elements such as soil, minerals, and plants. Themes include reflections on one’s homeland, interpretations of environmental change, and nature as a vessel of memory.

In contemporary society, nature has long been viewed as something to use or control. With the advent of sustainability, its meaning is being reconsidered—causing it to be seen not only as an environment, but as a source of cultural memory, identity, and

sensory experience. The shift from “mastering nature” to “coexisting with nature” is a key issue in today’s art. Kamonchanok Panuwed’s My First Spring captures her emotional responses to seasonal changes during her residency in Taiwan. Sato Masayuki’s Shell Nest – Taipei uses the shell as a symbol of containment, expressing impressions from his time creating in Yingge.

“Sustainable Nature” is more than an art show—it is an invitation to rethink our relationship with the natural world. We welcome visitors to the Yingge Ceramics Museum to experience the memories and cultural reflections embedded in these international artists’ works.
